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<b>English Language Arts</b>	Enrichment: All GT students are placed in a pull-out GT FIT (focused intervention) class where they receive differentiated and enrichment programming. Also, students can participate in Knowledge Bowl, Science Fair, MathCounts, Destination Imagination. Students can work on extended or creative writing during the GT Intervention class.
<b>Mathematics</b>	Advanced coursework, subject acceleration. Students have the opportunity to accelerate in math if they meet the criteria determined by the math department. Students in advanced math have the opportunity to accelerate to HS geometry if they take Algebra as a 7th grader.
<b>Science</b>	Enrichment: Students can participate in Science Fair.
<b>Social Studies</b>	Enrichment: National History Day Projects
<b>World Language</b>	Students can choose to be in a semester long spanish class.
<b>Leadership</b>	Student council, Specific leadership coursework
<b>Music</b>	Advanced coursework: Students have the opportunity to apply to be in advanced band and eventually apply to be in Jazz band. Choir and advanced choir opportunities
